

To all users of Cambridge Gun Club Rifle Range,

There has been continued debate with range users on the use of muzzle breaks on the 100-yard range. We are implementing a new protocol with the goal that both muzzle break and non-muzzle break shooters can enjoy their time on the range.

As from **Wednesday 14th August**, we will be introducing a **limited detail at 10:00am-11:30am** on all shooting days, (Wednesday through Sunday), where **NO MUZZLE BREAKS OVER .223 CALIBRE**, will be allowed. All details after the 10am detail will be mixed sessions, where larger calibre muzzle breaks may be used.

The normal notification (putting MB at the end of your name, on the booking calendar) will still be required if you intend to use any muzzle break on **ALL** details, (including 10am bookings where calibres .223 & below, may use muzzle brakes) so we can try to separate MB users from non MB users to ensure shooter safety and comfort.

We hope that this will be a solution to provide those who wish to have a more peaceful shooting environment a period where this can be achieved, whilst also allowing competition/long distance shooters the continued availability to use their muzzle breaks.

Please keep in mind - it is inevitable that we can never please everyone, however, we consider this to be the fairest and simplest way, to hopefully accommodate all shooters.
