

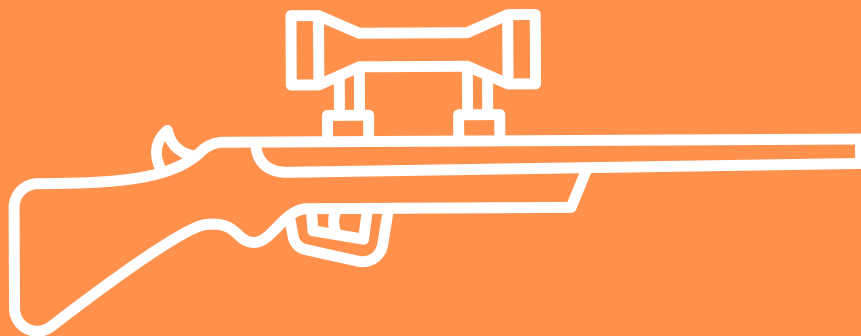

THE COURSE

This NRA-approved Rifle Training Course is designed to give a thorough introduction to full-bore rifle shooting. As you may already know, applying for a Firearms Certificate (FAC) isn't a straightforward process. This course is intended to support you in working towards obtaining your FAC.

Upon completing the course—and successfully passing—you will be issued a letter of recommendation to include with your application, confirming the training you have undertaken.

The course is suitable for complete beginners with no prior experience, as well as those with some familiarity, as it starts with the fundamentals and builds from there.

Once you enrol, you will receive pre-course learning materials. While all content will be covered during the training, a significant amount of information is delivered over a short period, so reviewing these materials in advance will help you prepare and get the most out of the course.

WHEN IS THE COURSE?

The course is delivered intensively over two days. If there are no suitable dates available on the website, please contact a member of the Reception team to discuss upcoming options.

After completing the course, you will need to undertake a minimum of six practice sessions, although you are welcome to complete additional sessions if you wish.

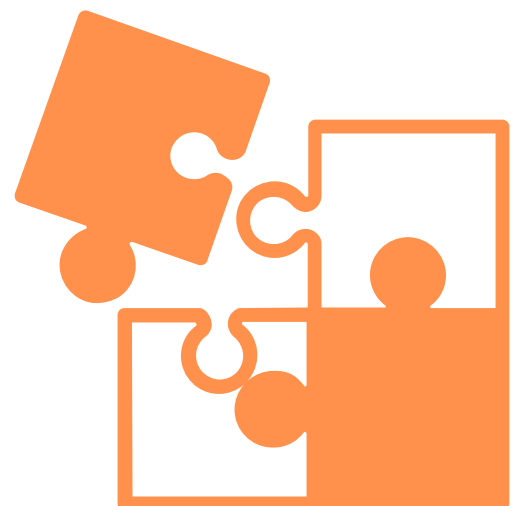
You will remain a probationary member for three months following the initial two-day course. At the end of this period, and once all required practice sessions have been completed, you can progress to full membership and will receive the necessary documentation to support your firearms application.

Each training day runs from 9:30am to approximately 4:00pm.

THE MODULES & WHAT YOU'LL LEARN

Mod 1	Safety, the basics of good handling skills and an introduction to the Principles of Marksmanship.
Mod 2	Scopes, sighting systems, iron sights, MOA and shooters measurements.
Mod 3	Windage, scorecards, target marking.
Mod 4/5	Range booking procedure, bisley zero range, revision and exam.

The NRA probationary course not only involves training in the safe use and handling of various different types of firearm, but also in the legal aspects of firearms use and ownership. The course stresses the absolute necessity of maintaining a responsible attitude towards all aspects of firearms use. You will be educated in all aspects of target shooting, grow your knowledge set and improve your newly developed skills.



COURSE COST SUMMARY

The cost for the intensive course is £599 per person.

This payment is required upfront, when you sign up to the intensive course. You will then have additional practice fees & membership fees (see below)

Any unused ammunition can be kept for you in the gun shop for a short time if required, but please do try to use them up as we are tight on storage space!

PRACTICE

You are required to do a minimum of 6 practices within the 3 months following the course (2 practices on .22 calibre, 2 practices on .223 calibre & 2 practices on .308 calibre).

You will receive 3 vouchers (1 x .22, 1 x .223 & 1 x .308) where your practice session, including ammunition, is FOC. The other practices have a fee (as per the 'course cost summary' page, where practice costs are listed). There is no fee for gun hire for these practice sessions.

You will need to book a lane for practice, via our website (but this will be explained to you during the course).

Dates will open approximately 2 weeks ahead. If the date is not showing as available to book within that 2 week date range, the range is full/unavailable. Naturally weekends will book up faster than weekdays.

Please do not contact us in advance to arrange any guns/ammo - You just request them from the gun shop on arrival to your session, after visiting reception.

If you need to cancel a booking, you can do so via the confirmation email you would have received when you made your booking. Scroll down to the bottom, there is a cancel button. Please ensure you cancel your space if you are unable to attend.

MEMBERSHIP & COURSE COMPLETION

After completing the training course, you will need to take out full membership in order for us to issue your letter of recommendation, which is required for your firearms application.

Your letter of recommendation is valid for 12 months from the date it is issued (the day you begin your membership). If you are unable or do not wish to take out membership immediately, you may remain a probationary member for a grace period of up to six months from your course completion date (Mod 4/5). Please note that while you remain a probationary member, a lane fee of £15 per session will still apply.

Full membership allows unlimited use of the range without time or usage restrictions, and no lane fees are charged. The standard annual membership fee is £330 for a 12-month period from the date of joining. However, as a course participant, you will receive a discounted rate of £280 for your first year. You will be issued a membership card once you become a full member.

Please be aware that a letter of recommendation cannot be issued prior to you becoming a full member, thus you will not be able to use this as support for your FAC. As mentioned, membership must be taken out within six months of completing the course. It is your responsibility to keep track of this timeframe, as we do not send reminders.

If you have exceptional circumstances that may prevent you from meeting these deadlines, please contact us to discuss your situation.

WHAT TO DO NEXT?

If you would like to enrol on the training course, please complete the 'Training Course Application Form' which can be found on the training course page of our website.

You can return the form in any of the following ways:

- Complete it digitally and attach it to an email
- Print it, fill it in, take a photo, and email it to us
- Drop it off to us

Please let us know which course group you would like to join (if available). If none of the listed dates are suitable, please indicate this when submitting your form. Once received, we will then take payment to secure your place.

Please note that all course applications must be submitted to the Firearms Department, where the necessary checks will be carried out. If an application is rejected, the Firearms Department will inform us, and we will notify you accordingly. However, they do not provide us with the reasons for any refusal. If you wish to query a decision, you will need to contact the Firearms Department directly. Rejections are rare, but if you are unable to take part in the course as a result, your deposit will be refunded.

While we aim to submit your application to the Firearms Department as quickly as possible, responses are not always immediate. In the unlikely event that a refusal is received after the course has begun, we will only be able to refund any remaining balance of your deposit at that stage.

Rifle course payments are non-refundable. Due to the high demand and limited availability of places on these courses, all bookings are final and no refunds will be issued once a place has been secured.

In the event that we are required to cancel a course for any reason, a refund will be provided. Additionally, as outlined earlier in this document, if Firearms Licensing refuses your application for any reason, any remaining fees for uncompleted modules will be refunded.

Please note that if you choose to withdraw from the course, either prior to commencement or after the course has begun, no refund will be available, as your reserved place could otherwise have been allocated to another participant.
